**Proverbs 28:8-14 (HCSB)**

These proverbs use antithetic parallelism. This is a statement followed by the opposite of the initial statement. Solomon points to userer trying to get wealthy on the backs of the poor but the interest ends up in the hands of a charitable person. To a worldly man, the next proverb is against their world view. For our prayers to be heard, we must have faith in God not in ourselves or the world.

Evil folks can expect bad results at some time, whether they purposely deceive, have an inflated ego, display wickedness, or turn their back on God. When we pursue righteousness, our inheritance is from God, we have discernment, we rejoice in life, we willingly confess (Psalm 51), and delight in reverence. We should remember that the proverbs are not guarantees of success, rather, a promise of God's providence in our lives.

Be the pursuer of God not a lover of the world.




# Realm Connect
